According to a World Bank report, Indonesia is now the world's third-biggest emitter of greenhouse gases. At the G-20 Leaders Summit in Pittsburgh, Indonesia declared that it is prepared, by 2020, to reduce emissions by 26 percent, target a billion ton CO2 reduction by 2050 and work at making forestry a net sink sector by 2030.

Although very rich in renewable energy resources, especially geothermal, hydropower and biomass, these resources are still largely unexploited or under developed. Indonesia possesses the world's largest reserve of geothermal energy. As it has not made much use of them, they now hold immense potential for development. The Government has backed up an initiative to implement the use of more renewable energy by 2025, with the introduction of tax oriented incentives, aimed to invite more global investment into the region and in turn optimally exploit the expanse of natural resources available for this purpose.

Therefore, Renewables Indonesia is timely and will provide an important platform for local and international discussion and collaboration at both the public and private sector levels to support the urgent need for management and development of the country's sustainable energy, green resources and environmental technology needs.
