5. Application

All potential exhibitors wishing to take part in the event must express their wish to do so by fully completing and signing - with a legally binding signatures - the "Application" form and submitting it to the Organizer at the earliest opportunity or at the latest by the application deadline. **The deadline for application is 14 October 2011.**

With the application, exhibitors express to the Organizer their serious interest in taking part in the event as exhibitors. All exhibits must be described precisely on the application form. Co-exhibitors must be named on the application form for co-exhibitors. The same particulars must be specified as for the exhibitor. Incomplete applications cannot be considered. This application procedure does not apply to organizers of joint stands. They are not exhibitors as defined by the Terms of Participation. Organizers of joint stands have to fill in the application form for joint stands which can be obtained from the Organizer.

6. Exhibitors and Approved Exhibits

All National and international manufacturers or their Indonesian subsidiaries, general importers and specialist dealers authorized by the manufacturers are admitted as exhibitors. All exhibits must correspond to the relevant range of exhibits for this trade fair and be designated by name and category on the application form. Organizer has the final decision.

All exhibits must be listed individually on the registration form giving an exact description. Any display of inflammable or pungent exhibits or exhibits whose demonstration entails noise requires the prior written consent of the Organizer.

The Organizer is entitled to demand the removal of items which have not been listed in the application form or prove to be dangerous, a cause of annoyance or otherwise unsuitable. If this demand is not complied with, the said items will be removed by the Organizer at the expense of the exhibitor.

7. Co-exhibitors

Permission for co-exhibitors must be requested in writing. A compulsory registration fee of USD 200 for each co-exhibitor will be charged.

A co-exhibitor is one who presents his own goods or services, using his own staff, at the stand of another exhibitor (the main exhibitor). This definition includes group companies and subsidiaries. Agents and representatives are not admitted as co-exhibitors.

The definition of an additionally represented company is as follows: In the case of an exhibitor who is also a manufacturer, an additionally represented company is any other company whose goods or services are offered by the exhibitor. If an exhibitor who is a distributor wants to display not only the products of one manufacturer but also goods and services of other companies, then these count as additionally represented companies.

Additionally represented companies are not allowed on the stand.

8. Registration

Registration must be submitted using the enclosed form, acknowledging the acceptance of these Terms of Participation. The completed registration form bearing a legally binding signature of the Exhibitor should be mailed to the Organizer.

9. Participation Fees

The costs of participation to be paid are as set forth in the participation options described under Clauses 9.1 to 9.5 below. The general services and facilities (9.1) are included in all options under 9.2, 9.3 and 9.4.

Participation options:

9.1 General Services and Facilities

- Provision of net fair space (stand area), not for co-exhibitors
- Air conditioning of halls during show days
- Cleaning of aisles and passages in halls (exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their stands)
- General security service (no individual stand surveillance)

9.2 Rental for "Stand Space Only / Raw Space"

Raw Space : USD 300 per m² (min. 24 m²)

Services and facilities for "Raw Space Only" option:

- Space area without structure, net and stand number

9.3 Rental for "Shell Scheme-Package incl. Stand Space"

Shell Scheme : USD 360 per m² (min. 9 m²)

Services and facilities for "Shell Scheme Package" option:

- Stand assembly and dismantling, include all ancillary costs, comprising:
- Wall Paneling
 - Fascia with Company's Name
 - Table, Chairs
 - Lighting
 - 13amp Single Phase Power Point
 - Information Desk
 - Carpet

9.4 Rental for "Outdoor Area"

Outdoor Area : USD 190 per m² (min. 50 m²)

Services and facilities for "Outdoor Area" option:

9.5 Upper Storey Stand Space

Upper storey stand space may not exceed 50% of the ground floor area applied and should have a minimum of 50 m²

9.6 All additional technical services required, e.g. power, security, connection of water, local labour, are to be provided exclusively by the Organizer at and extra charge and can be ordered using special order forms. Fees for additional stand assembly services supplementary to those included in the participation fee, and any orders for services shall be agreed or charged according to Organizer's price lists valid at the time of the event.

10. Exhibitors' Passes

For the time in which the trade fair is held, each exhibitor receives the following number of exhibitors' passes free of charge:

9 to 14	5	50 to 100	30
15 to 23	10	101 to 400	40
24 to 49	20	more than 400	maximum 50

The entitlement of exhibitors' passes include those of co-exhibitors or additionally represented companies included on the stand.

An additional charge will be applicable for extra exhibitors' passes which can be ordered from the Organizer at a later stage.

Exhibitors' passes are intended solely for stand personnel and must not be passed onto third parties. Any misuse on the part of the exhibitor entitles the Organizer to demand from the exhibitor the return of or confiscate the given exhibitor's pass. Exhibitor's pass is issued in the bearer's name.

11. Admission

Admission of exhibitors and listed exhibits is in the sole discretion of the Organizer. Exhibitors will be informed of admission in writing and admission shall apply only to the Exhibitor stated therein. The contract comes into force on confirmation of admission.

The Organizer shall be entitled to revoke any admission if such admission was based on a misunderstanding, false information or if the preconditions for approval no longer apply.

Admission applies only to the listed exhibits, the exhibitor is entitled to restrict the listed exhibits to which the application has been made. Should the Organizer be compelled to relocate or change individual stands, entrances, exits or aisles at a later point in time, this shall not give rise to any claims.

Following admission by the Organizer (conclusion of contract), the obligation to pay the participation fee shall remain legally binding even if, for example, the authorities in the exhibiting country do not approve, in whole or part, the Exhibitor's import requirements, or if exhibits for any reason whatsoever fail to arrive in time or to arrive at all (e.g. owing to loss, delays in transit or customs), or if the Exhibitor or his agent is delayed or even unable to attend. Should the Exhibitor or his agent fail to take over the allocated stand area two days prior to the beginning of the Exhibition, such area may be otherwise disposed of in such manner as the Organizer shall determine in its absolute discretion. This shall not release the Exhibitor from his contractual obligations or entitle him to demand for refund or lodge any other claims against the Organizer.

12. Terms of Payment

All payments to be made in USD

The invoice amount is to be paid in full without any deductions (e.g. applicable taxes) and free from charges. The exhibitor is liable for payment of applicable taxes, if any.

All remittance are payable to MMI Asia Pte Ltd., in the currency net of bank charges and currency exchange charges and must be made by draft or direct transfer to :

Participation costs shall be due upon approval of the registration. The exhibitor shall be billed for such amounts. 50% of the participation costs must be paid upon receipt of invoice. The balance shall be paid no later than 30 December 2011.

In case of default by the Exhibitor of payment of any sum due to the Organizer, interest shall be charged on the outstanding sum at a rate of 7% p.a. Where payment dates are not met, the Organizer shall be entitled to rescind the contract or otherwise dispose of the stand area and the Exhibitor shall be responsible for all losses suffered by the Organizer. Item 13 of the Terms of Participation shall apply.

13. Withdrawal or Non-Participation

The Exhibitor is entitled to withdraw his registration prior to the approval of his registration.

Following approval, the Exhibitor must pay the full rental even if he withdraws his application or fails to exhibit. The Organizer reserves the rights to assert claims for any damage.

The Organizer is entitled to rescind the contract in the event of an application for composition or bankruptcy proceedings in respect of the Exhibitor's assets or where such an application is rejected on the grounds of insufficient assets. The Exhibitor shall inform the Organizer thereof at once.

14. Use of Site and Safety

Precaution measures such as guards or other means of protection must be taken to protect the public from any moving or working exhibits. Such moving or working exhibits shall only be demonstrated or operated by persons authorised by the exhibitor and shall not be left running in the absence of such persons. Display of such working or moving exhibits must have the Organizer's prior written approval.

Any demonstrations requires the permission of the Organizer and related authorities.

Publicity materials may only be distributed from the Exhibitor's own stand or shell booth. No advertising, demonstration or canvassing for business may be carried out anywhere else within the Exhibition Venue. No exhibits or advertising signs shall be placed outside the confines of the Exhibitor's stand.

No stickers, posters, hangers or other materials shall be allowed to hang on fascia boards.

Gas-filled balloons shall not be permitted at the Exhibition Venue under any circumstances.

Exhibitor's stand must be manned by authorised and competent representative of the Exhibitor at all times during the Exhibition. Such representative must be fully conversant with the Exhibitor's products and/or services and shall be duly authorised to negotiate and conclude contracts for the sale of the Exhibitors' products or services. The Exhibitor and its representative shall comply with these conditions and directions that the Organizer or its agents may give before or during the Exhibition.

15. Technical Guidelines

The technical guidelines are a constituent part of these Terms of Participation and must be adhered to. The technical guidelines shall be handed over to the exhibitor at the latest with the order form for services.

16. Insurance and Liability

The insurance of exhibits against all risks during transit and during the exhibitions particularly against damages theft, etc. is only the responsibility of the exhibitor.

The exhibitor is liable for all damages caused to third parties through his participation in the exhibition, including damages to buildings on the exhibition grounds, themselves and installations.

The Organizer in no way whatsoever is liable for any damages or theft of exhibits even in cases where they take over stand building or display work. Moreover, through acceptance of these Rules and Regulations, the exhibitor expressly releases The Organizer from all claims for recovery of damages by third parties that might arise.

17. Circulars

Once the stand areas have been allocated, the Exhibitors shall receive circulars giving information on preparations for and the staging of the fair. Any consequences arising from disregarding these circulars shall be borne by the Exhibitors.

18. Reservation

Regulations and guidelines issued by responsible agencies of the host country that deviate from these Rules and Regulations for Exhibitors or caused additional limitations shall have priority at all times. The Organizers of the trade fair and/or the lessor of the exhibition grounds shall not be liable for damages nor other disadvantages suffered by the Exhibitor.

The Organizer of the trade fair shall be entitled to postpone, shorten, extend or cancel the trade fair of joint exhibition and to close it down temporarily or permanently, in part or in whole if unforeseen events such as force majeure, nature disasters, armed conflict, civil unrest, terror attacks, demonstrations, strikes, failure or hindrance of traffic and/or communications links make such measures necessary. In the event of postponement, curtailment, extension or closure, the Exhibitor shall not be entitled to claim compensation for any damages incurred by him thereby. If the Exhibitor is no longer interested in participation by virtue of the measures taken and he declines to occupy the exhibition space allocated to him as a result thereof, he may withdraw from the contract. The Exhibitor shall provide notification of said withdrawal in writing immediately upon becoming aware of the change. Item 13 of the Terms of Participation shall apply correspondingly to obligations of the Exhibitor.

Where the Exhibitor has placed orders with the Organizers for services supplementary to those covered by the participation fee, he shall be billed for the costs incurred until this point in time.

19. Photography, Filming, Video Recording, etc.

Filming, photography and producing sketches or video recordings within the trade fair grounds are permitted only to those persons authorised for the purpose by the Organizer. It is under no circumstances permitted to make photographic or other images or recordings of other exhibitors' stands. In the event of infringement of this rule, the Organizer can demand that the recorded material be surrendered, and take legal steps to achieve that end. Photographs of stands taken outside normal opening times require the Organizer's prior consent. The costs incurred thereby will be charged to the exhibitor, insofar as they are not borne by the photographer. The Organizer is entitled to have photographs, drawings, films and video recordings made of events at the trade fair, of stands and exhibits, and to use them for advertising or general press publication.

20. Setting up, dismantling and staffing stands

The publicized dates of setting up and dismantling must be adhered to. The Organizer can otherwise dispose of stands, which have still not been occupied on the last set-up day.

Stands are to be equipped properly and manned with informed personnel during the official opening hours for the entire duration of the trade fair. Exhibitors are not permitted to remove trade fair goods or dismantle their stands before the trade fair has closed. If they break this rule, the Organizer is entitled to demand a penalty of USD500 per incident.

21. Additional Rules & Regulations

The Organizer reserves the rights to interpret, alter and amend any of these Terms of Participation and to issue additional rules and regulations at any time they consider necessary for the orderly operation of the Exhibition. All interpretation of these Terms of Participation and any additional rules and regulations by the Organizer shall be final.

The Exhibitor shall abide by the rules and regulations of the Exhibition Venue, which are deemed to be integral parts of these Terms of Participation. In the event of conflict between the provisions of such rules and these Terms of Participation, these Terms of Participation shall prevail. Copy of rules of and regulations of the Exhibition Venue is available from the Organizer on request.

22. Final Provisions

All exhibitor claims against the Organizer must be made in writing. The statutory period of limitation begins on the last day of the exhibition. Agreements that deviate from these or supplementary terms must be in writing.

Singapore law and the English text shall be prevailing. Place of fulfilment and jurisdiction is Singapore. However, the Organizer reserves the right to bring any claims before the court of the place at which the exhibitor has his place of business.
